As requested, this memo provides a summary of the private well survey completed to date at the Lafarge Oro Pit. The private well survey was initiated to satisfy the Hydrogeologic (Groundwater) monitoring conditions outlined on the approved Site Plan.

The monitoring conditions indicate that, with the permission of home owners, water levels and water samples be obtained at domestic wells within 300 metres of the site. The attached air photo shows the addresses of the surrounding properties, in addition to the location of specific residences within 300 metres of the Oro Pit.

The first step in satisfying this monitoring condition is to complete a water well survey to obtain information regarding these wells and requesting permission to obtain a water level measurement and water quality sample. This work was initiated by Eric Isenor (Oro Pit Plant Manager, Lafarge). Eric delivered a contact / information letter and request. This was followed up by two door to door visits by Dave Nahrgang (Groundwater Science Corp.), on December 17, 2012 and February 21, 2013. A second letter was delivered on February 21st again requesting participation and stating that the survey would be finalized by March 8, 2013.

The survey results to date are summarized on the attached table. A total of 20 properties were visited. As illustrated in the summary, on Line 6 North there are 5 residences within 300 m of the pit; and, on Line 7 North there is only one residence within 300 m of the pit (note that this property is also owned by Lafarge). The remainder of the properties within the 300 m survey radius are either vacant, County Forest lands, or in use as aggregate extraction sites (gravel pits).

One survey response was received and based on the permission granted a water quality sample was obtained on February 21st. In addition, on-site water level and water quality monitoring has been initiated. We are expecting the first analysis results this week.
