PROJECT OVERVIEW

Since stepping into highway maintenance, Lafarge has been successful as one of the first companies to obtain a CMA contract. in short order, we became one of the largest maintenance contractors in Alberta - operating five CMAs at our peak. Lafarge maintained five Construction Management Agreement (CMA) contracts in northeastern Alberta from 1995 to 2006.

Lafarge maintained 6,000 kms of two-lane equivalent highway in CMA 7, 8, 14, 15, and 16 over the course of 11 years. We maintained and operated 30 material storage yards, 87 plow trucks, 10 graders, and 27 loaders. The scope of work included crack sealing, asphalt patching, ditch maintenance, sign and guardrail maintenance, vegetation maintenance, and winter maintenance operations.

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

Lafarge maintained an area of approximately 25,000 km². We were responsible for all aspects of highway maintenance including:

- crack sealing;
- asphalt patching;
- ditch maintenance;

We staged equipment in significant Alberta hubs including Fort McMurray, Cold Lake, Lloydminster and Camrose.
